Estate Plan*

A simple, flexible, and versatile way to ensure the Ocean Grove Historic Preservation Society / Jersey Shore Arts Center can flourish in the future is to make a gift in your will or living trust, known as a charitable bequest. By including a bequest to the Ocean Grove Historic Preservation Society for the Jersey Shore Arts Center in your will or living trust, you will make a difference for years to come.

This flexible gift option can be revised at any time and can be made as a specific amount or a percentage of your estate—allowing you to also take care of your family. In addition, your gift entitles your estate to an unlimited federal estate tax charitable deduction.

Individuals may make the following kinds of bequests to the JSAC:

Specific bequest: A sum of money, an appreciated asset, or property

Residuary bequest: All or a percentage of the assets remaining in your estate after specific bequests and all other expenses are paid.

Contingent bequest: A bequest to the Center that comes into effect if your primary beneficiary does not survive you.

Sample Bequest Language

I give, devise, and bequeath to the Ocean Grove Historic Preservation Society, Ocean Grove NJ, the sum of \$____ (or state percentage of estate or a description of the specific asset) for the benefit of the Jersey Shore Arts Center and its general purposes."
